It's Lent Again! We are invited to journey through this Season to the most important Christian Festival of the Year – HOLY WEEK AND EASTER. ## ASH WEDNESDAY: 5<sup>th</sup> March

Today is kept as a day of **Fasting** and **Abstinence**. It is a day we should make every effort to join with our Parish Community at Mass and so get Lent off to a good start. At Mass we will be signed with the ashes, the traditional sign reminding us that this is a season of **Repentance** and **Renewal**. We are called to "turn away from sin and be faithful to the gospel".

## **STATION MASS**

Lenten Station Masses (not to be confused with Stations of the Cross) have long been celebrated in Rome and in recent years have become increasingly popular in other places. Bishop Alan Hopes is going to celebrate a Station Mass in each of the deaneries of the diocese. The Mass for North Norfolk Deanery will be on Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> March at 7.30pm at the Church of St Joseph, Sheringham. From 6.30-7.15pm there will be confessions in the church and following the Mass refreshment will be served in the hall. It is important that we support this first official deanery visit of the bishop to our deanery, so please make a note in your diary and don't forget to offer lifts to others who may like to attend but have no transport.

This will replace the Lenten Parish Stations Masses we have celebrated over the past few years.

The **CAFOD envelopes** will be distributed on the weekend  $8/9^{\text{th}}$  March for returning the following weekend. ### Parish Reflection Day


"The Joy of the Gospel"

## EVENTS AT SACRED HEART, NORTH WALSHAM

#### **LENT LUNCHES**

Will take place on the Thursdays of Lent from 12.30-1.30pm in the St Nicholas Room *(behind St Nicholas Church, North Walsham)* starting on  $13^{th}$  March and ending on  $10^{th}$  April. The lunch is a simple one of excellent homemade soup and bread, with fresh fruit. The cost is £3.50. Proceeds *(after expenses)* to Christian Aid. Each week there will be a short reflection from one of the Church Leaders of the town based around The Sermon on the Mount. These lunches are a very good way for the Christians of North Walsham to get to know each other better.

<u>STATIONS OF THE CROSS</u> will take place on <u>Fridays</u> of Lent at 12noon commencing  $14^{th}$  March.

#### **OTHER IDEAS FOR LENT**

- Attend a Mass during the week (see weekly newsletter for times)
- Come to Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament on a Thursday morning a time of prayer and Adoration following on from the 9.30am Mass at North Walsham.
- Read St Matthew's Gospel (or another book of the bible).
- Read a Spiritual Book over the weeks of Lent e.g. "Walk with me"; or borrow a book from the spiritual library at your church.
- Make the "Stations of the Cross" privately, or with a few friends each week of Lent.
- Spend a Quiet Day at Walsingham.
- Think of something you could give up for Lent and the money you save give to Lenten Alms, which as a diocese will this year be divided between the local children's Hospices in East Anglia and the St Francis Leprosy Guild, which supports about eighty Leprosy Centres around the world, mainly in Africa and Asia. There is a designated Wall-slot at North Walsham and baskets at St John of the Cross and St Helens; or hand in at the end of Lent.
- Think of a good action to do for someone else on each of the days of Lent.
- There are many other positive ideas once you start thinking about it!
